Follow these steps to keep your Cox-Box, Cox-Vox, Microphones & Wiring static-free and reliable for years.

Note: Customer will need to obtain Isopropyl (rubbing) Alcohol, not included, prior to performing these steps.

Cox Box Panel Connectors - MONTHLY

WASH the Cox Box panel with warm water and mild soap. RINSE well. DRY thoroughly.

CLEAN



 Use alcohol to clean the inside of all the connector sockets



Insert supplied
metal brush into
each socket several
times to loosen
and clean debris



 Next use a pipe cleaner to remove any excess alcohol and debris.

PROTECT



Apply Nyogel grease to each of the sockets.
Be careful not to overfill, a small amount is needed.



2. Apply Nyogel to foam swab provided.



 Using foam swab, apply Nyogel to the entire outside of both rubber connectors, not the plastic.

 Apply Nyogel grease to both sockets. Be careful not to overfill, a small amount is needed.



Apply Nyogel to foam swab provided.



 Using foam swab, apply Nyogel to the entire outside of rubber connector.

Charging and Storing Your Cox Box

Place your unit on charge whenever not in use, but avoid leaving it on charge for more than three days continuously. At the end of the season, charge the unit for 12 hours, disconnect the microphone and charger, and store in a cool dry place until ready to use next season.
